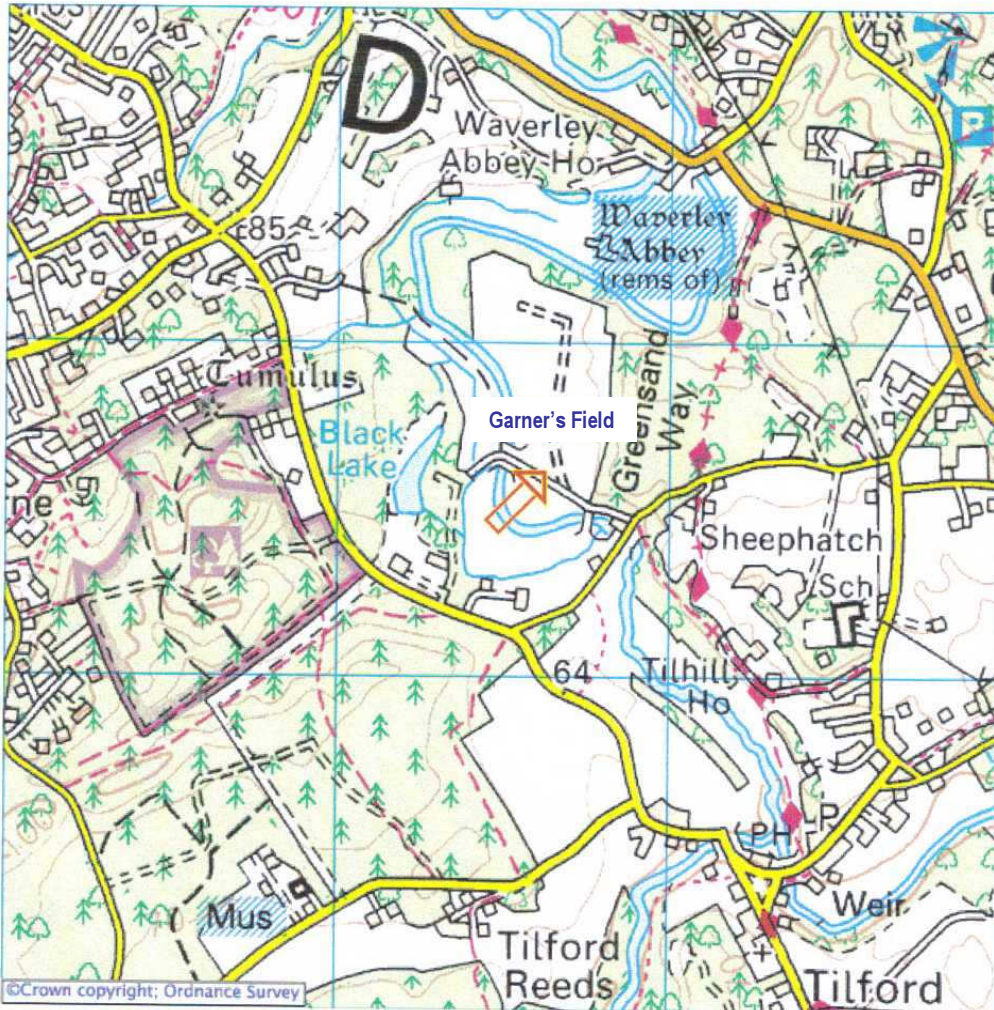


FARNHAM DISTRICT SCOUT HEADQUARTERS
Garner's Field Campsite
Sheephatch Lane, Tilford



Directions for Garners Field Scout Campsite

Address Sheephatch Lane
 Tilford
 Near Farnham
 Surrey
(The site does not have a postal address but, for navigation purposes, the nearest post code GU10 2AQ will get you to Sheephatch Lane)

Sheephatch Lane can be approached from Farnham by either the Tilford Road (take the right-hand fork over the level crossing at Farnham station), or by taking the left-hand fork into Waverley Lane (B 3001 to Elstead)

*Tilford Road Approach (weight limit of 7.5 tons) **Easiest route to find us from Farnham*

Follow the Tilford Road out of Farnham until you see the blue signs warning about a weak bridge. (About 2 miles from the level crossing)

Turn Left into Sheephatch Lane and cross Tilfordmill Bridge (weight limit 7.5 tons).

As you cross the bridge there is a house on the left-hand side with a gated track to the right-hand side of the house.

There are signs warning about unauthorised access and 5mph limits. Follow the track past stables on the left-hand side, and you will reach the entrance to the Girl Guides campsite (Herons Wey) on your right.

Keep straight on past the Guides site and follow the track until you reach the sign posted entrance to the Scouts Campsite.

Waverley Lane Approach

Follow Waverley Lane out of Farnham.

Pass by Waverley Abbey ruins (sharp left and right turning) and after passing Crooksbury Road on your left, turn right into Tilford Street. (About 2.6 miles from the level crossing)

Follow road for a few hundred yards and turn right into Sheephatch Lane.

(There is a small sign pointing to Herons Wey)

Proceed down hill and turn right into gated track just before the house on the right and before the weak bridge.
